## **Key Findings**

- 1) Overall 97% compliance for this review.
- 2) All Districts and SOD achieved 94% or higher for this review. The 6th District achieved an overall score of 100% while the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> Districts each scored 99%. 22 individual platoons/units scored 100%.
- 3) 24 officers did not attain a perfect score, but only 7 had more than one call for service without a video. Two officers reported BWC malfunctions on their trip sheets but were still counted for this review (2 out of 6 calls had a video).
- 4) All platoons (A, B, and C) and General Assignment Units collectively achieved 95% or higher for this review. The 5<sup>th</sup> District General Assignment Unit only had a video for one of its two calls, scoring a 50%.
- 5) SOD/K9 did not have any qualifying videos.
