NARRATIVE

ON SUNDAY JUNE 5, 2016, AT ABOUT 4:21 AM., OFFICERS REGINALD KOELLER AND TYRONE MILLS, MANNING UNIT 726C, OF THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS SEVENTH POLICE DISTRICT, RECEIVED A CALL VIA NEW ORLEANS POLICE DEPARTMENT DISPATCHER, TO INVESTIGATE A SIGNAL 52F (FIRE) WHICH OCCURRED IN THE 4400 BLOCK OF FLITE STREET. AFTER FURTHER INVESTIGATION, OFFICERS KOELLER AND MILLS CHANGED THE SIGNAL OF THE INCIDENT TO A SIGNAL 29U (UNCLASSIFIED DEATH). THE FACTS AND CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING THIS INCIDENT AND INVESTIGATION ARE DOCUMENTED IN THE FOLLOWING NEW ORLEANS POLICE DEPARTMENT INCIDENT REPORT:

ON THE AFOREMENTIONED TIME AND DATE, OFFICERS KOELLER AND MILLS ARRIVED IN THE 4400 BLOCK OF FLITE STREET AND OBSERVED A BLACK, FOUR DOOR, TOYOTA CAMRY, BEARING LOUISIANA LICENSE PLATE XXT/19, ENGULFED IN FIRE. OFFICERS KOELLER AND MILLS FURTHER OBSERVED NEW ORLEANS FIRE DEPARTMENT ENGINE 6, WAS ON THE SCENE AND IN THE PROCESS OF EXTINGUISHING THE FIRE. OFFICER KOELLER WAS THEN APPROACHED BY FIRE FIGHTER ISRAEL DAVIS, WHO ADVISED OFFICER KOELLER THERE WAS A BURNED BODY IN THE FRONT PASSENGER SIDE SEAT OF THE VEHICLE. OFFICER KOELLER SUBSEQUENTLY APPROACHED THE VEHICLE AND OBSERVED THE CHARD REMAINS OF A HUMAN BEING LYING FACE DOWN IN THE FRONT PASSENGER SIDE SEAT OF THE VEHICLE. OFFICER KOELLER SUBSEQUENTLY CONDUCTED A LICENSE PLATE CHECK ON THE VEHICLE'S LICENSE PLATE AND LEARNED THE VEHICLE WAS REGISTERED TO MR. JOHN PATRICK SIMMONS, RESIDING AT 4935 SANDALWOOD DRIVE.

OFFICER KOELLER IMMEDIATELY ALERTED NEW ORLEANS POLICE DEPARTMENT COMMAND DESK OF THIS DISCOVERY AND REQUESTED THE NEW ORLEANS POLICE DEPARTMENT HOMICIDE UNIT TO THE SCENE.

OFFICER KOELLER CONTACTED SERGEANT R. THOMAS, MANNING UNIT 720C, OF THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS SEVENTH POLICE DISTRICT, WHO ARRIVED ON THE SCENE AND SUPERVISED OFFICERS KOELLER AND MILLS INVESTIGATION OF THIS INCIDENT.

OFFICER KOELLER CONTACTED CITY OF NEW ORLEANS HOMICIDE DETECTIVE A. WALDRON, WHO ARRIVED ON THE SCENE AND CONDUCTED HIS INVESTIGATION OF THIS INCIDENT.

OFFICER KOELLER CONTACTED NEW ORLEANS FIRE DEPARTMENT ARSON INVESTIGATOR R. HOLLARD, MANNING UNIT 4299, WHO ARRIVED ON THE SCENE AND CONDUCTED HIS INVESTIGATION OF THIS INCIDENT. INVESTIGATOR HOLLARD ADVISED OFFICER KOELLER THE VEHICLE WAS IN FACT INTENTIONALLY SET ON FIRE.

OFFICER KOELLER THEN OBTAINED THE NAMES OF THE MEMBERS OF ENGINE 6 AND NOTED THEM FOR THIS REPORT. THE MEMBERS IDENTIFIED WERE FIRE FIGHTER GREGORY HOWARD, FIRE FIGHTER DARRICK SHELBY, FIRE FIGHTER ISRAEL DAVIS, AND FIRE CHIEF DAVID CONDON.

OFFICER KOELLER CONTACTED NEW ORLEANS EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE UNIT 6247, MANNED BY EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN THOMAS EVANS. TECHNICIAN EVANS ADVISED OFFICER THE BODY INSIDE OF THE VEHICLE WAS PRONOUNCED DECEASED AT 5:28AM, BY DOCTOR JEFF ELDER, DIRECTOR OF NEW ORLEANS EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE.

OFFICER KOELLER CONTACTED CORONER'S OFFICERS INVESTIGATOR JENNIFER TRIGUEROS, MANNING UNIT 5076, WHO ARRIVED ON THE SCENE AND CONDUCTED HER INVESTIGATION OF THIS INCIDENT. INVESTIGATOR TRIGUEROUS TOOK POSSESSION OF THE BODY INSIDE OF THE VEHICLE AND RELOCATED IT TO THE CORONER'S OFFICE FOR FURTHER INVESTIGATION.

OFFICER KOELLER CONTACTED CITY OF NEW ORLEANS, DEPARTMENT OF POLICE CRIME LAB UNIT 5133, MANNED BY TECHNICIAN S. LASTIE, WHO ARRIVED ON THE SCENE AND PROCESSED THE SCENE FOR EVIDENCE.

OFFICERS KOELLER AND MILLS BODY WORN CAMERAS WERE ACTIVATED THROUGHOUT THE INVESTIGATION OF THIS INCIDENT.
