16-(10) COMMITTED HOMICIDE BY SHOOTING

NARRATIVE

ON SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 25, 2017, AT ABOUT 9:30 PM., OFFICERS REGINALD KOELLER AND LEON PALOADE, MANNING UNIT 726C, OF THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS SEVENTH POLICE DISTRICT, RECEIVED A CALL VIA NEW ORLEANS POLICE DEPARTMENT DISPATCHER, TO INVESTIGATE A SIGNAL 30S (HOMICIDE BY SHOOTING) WHICH OCCURRED AT 4324 DOWNMAN ROAD. THE FACTS AND CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING THIS INCIDENT AND INVESTIGATION ARE DOCUMENTED IN THE FOLLOWING NEW ORLEANS POLICE DEPARTMENT INCIDENT REPORT:

ON THE AFOREMENTIONED TIME AND DATE, OFFICERS KOELLER AND PALOADE ARRIVED AT 4324 DOWNMAN ROAD, AT WHICH TIME; OFFICERS KOELLER AND PALOADE OBSERVED A BLACK FEMALE SUBJECT, LYING BETWEEN (2) TWO VEHICLES, SUFFERING FROM WHAT APPEARED TO BE MULTIPLE GUNSHOT WOUNDS. OFFICERS KOELLER AND PALOADE THEN LEARNED NEW ORLEANS EMS UNIT 3224 MANNED BY TECHNICIANS L. VARELA AND D. FREZEL HAD ARRIVED ON THE SCENE AND ATTEMPTED TO REVIVE THE VICTIM, HOWEVER; MET WITH NO AVAIL. OFFICERS KOELLER AND PALOADE THEN LEARNED DOCTOR HARRALL OF UNIVERSITY MEDICAL CENTER HAD PRONOUNCED THE VICTIM DECEASED AT 8:42 PM.

OFFICERS KOELLER AND PALOADE OBSERVED DETECTIVE R. BARRERE, MANNING UNIT 4173 OF THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS HOMICIDE UNIT, WAS ON THE SCENE. DETECTIVE BARRERE CONDUCTED HIS INVESTIGATION INTO THIS INCIDENT.

OFFICERS KOELLER AND PALOADE CONTACTED LIEUTENANT R. WILLIAMS, MANNING UNIT 710C, AND SERGEANT R. THOMAS UNIT 720C AND ADVISED THEM OF THIS INCIDENT. LIEUTENANT WILLIAMS AND SERGEANT THOMAS ARRIVED ON THE SCENE AND SUPERVISED OFFICERS KOELLER AND PALOADE'S INVESTIGATION INTO THIS INCIDENT.

OFFICERS KOELLER AND PALOADE OBSERVED NEW ORLEANS POLICE DEPARTMENT CRIME LAB UNIT 5124, MANNED BY TECHNICIANS T. BAN AND I. ADAMS WERE ON THE SCENE. TECHNICIANS BAN AND ADAMS PROCESSED THE SCENE FOR PHYSICAL EVIDENCE.

OFFICERS KOELLER AND PALOADE OBSERVED INVESTIGATOR R. LEWIS, MANNING UNIT 7297 OF THE ORLEANS PARISH CORONER'S OFFICE WAS ON THE SCENE. INVESTIGATOR LEWIS AND R. ROBINSON REMOVED THE DECEASED REMAINS FROM THE SCENE AND TRANSPORTED THEM TO THE CORONER'S OFFICE FOR FURTHER INVESTIGATION.

OFFICERS KOELLER AND PALOADE'S BODY WORN CAMERAS WERE ACTIVATED THROUGHOUT THE INVESTIGATION OF THIS INCIDENT.
